- Successful completion of a University Foundations Course
- Evidence of successful completion of one or more subjects in an equivalent Bachelor level university course
- Evidence of significant education work-related experience (minimum 2 years) plus a successful interview.

Non-Academic Entry Requirements, IELTS average band score of 7.5, with a score of at least 8.0 for Listening and Speaking and a score of at least 7.0 for Reading and Writing.

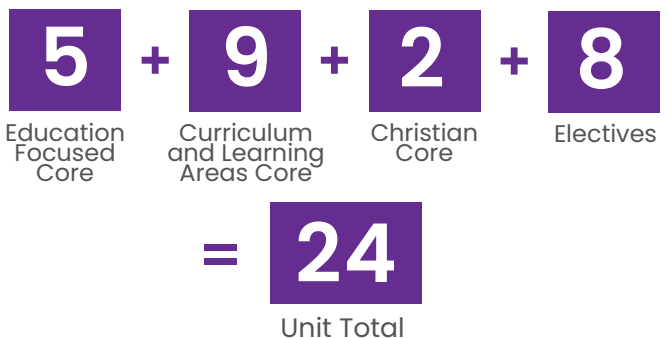
