Course Overview Description

Tabor's innovative **Master of Leadership** serves to equip graduates with the knowledge and skills necessary to successfully lead and effect change within organisations, whilst also providing the opportunity to **specialise** in a particular field that will be reflected on their academic transcript. This means that educators can now obtain a **specialised Master of Leadership award which has a focus on Educational Leadership.**

The Program

Tabor's **Master of Leadership** has been developed with **flexibility** in mind and will be offered over **quadmester** periods to accommodate busy teachers.

Completion of the program can be achieved in **18** months or less, depending on recognised prior learning, and will consist of the following components:

- 6 core leadership units
- 3 elective units, allowing students to develop expertise in a particular focus area, such as educational leadership.
- 9 leadership credentials, which can be obtained by demonstrating workplace leadership skills and experience.


